
The Qiblah Wall faces Mecca.


Some people would still be good because we know inside what is right and wrong even without rules.

The five pillars of Islam  
The first pillar is the Shahadah. The Shahadah means that there is only one god, Allah.  
The second pillar is Salat which is praying five times each day.  
The third pillar is Fasting in the month of Ramadan when you are only allowed to eat and drink when the moon is out.  
The fourth pillar is that every year a Muslim must give 2.5% of their money to charity. If you do not have much money, you do not have to do this.  
The fifth pillar is to go on pilgrimage to Mecca.

**THE FIVE PILLARS OF ISLAM.**

Islam is almost the most popular religion in the world. Islam has over 1000 million followers. Whoever follows Islam are called Muslims. Islam is mostly followed in the middle east, Asia and the north of Africa.



- 1 The 1st pillar is called the Shahadah. The Shahadah means there is only one god, the gods name is Allah.
- 2 Salat is the second it means praying five times a day.
- 3 Saom Islamic Fasting is not eating or drinking food when the sun is in the sky.
- 4 Zakat means each year people in Islam have to give usually 2.5% of their savings.
- 5 Hajj means Pilgrimage to Mecca.


**THE 5 PILLARS OF ISLAM.**

The 5 Pillars of Islam are:

- 1) The Great Shahadah (Declaration of Faith)
- 2) Pray 5 times a day
- 3) Fasting (only during the month of Ramadan)
- 4) Each year give money to charity
- 5) Hajj

Did you know?

- Fasting is when Muslims (people of religion) don't eat or drink during the light hours in day, from sun coming up and have a better relation with Allah.
- There is no single order in to follow, pillars are five pillars of Islam, all are equally important.
- Comparing and the 5 pillars demonstrates that the Muslims in Islam who first instead of going to Mecca you should.
- Muslim women have to wear head covered so they don't show their body to their God.

**THE FIVE PILLARS OF ISLAM**
