Key Vocabulary

- **Mark Making** - using pencil, crayons, charcoal etc to make marks, patterns and or drawings on paper or other materials.
- **Images** – pictures or photographs of objects.
- **Design** - planning and drawing what something you are going to make will look like.
- **Purpose** - the reason why something has been made and what it is used for
- **Piece of Artwork** – something that is drawn or painted.
- **Artist** - a person that creates a piece of art
- **Sculpture** - art that is made through changing wood, metal, clay or other materials
- **Sculptor** - a person who makes a sculpture
- **Mould** – to move and shape a material to a desired shape
- **Malleable** – a material that can be shape, hammered, rolled to change its shape.
- **3D art** - art that you can hold and see all around
- **2D art** - a flat piece of art, for example a drawing or a photo
- **Evaluate** – to look at theirs an others designs and sculptors and say how it could be made better and what they would do the same and differently.
