

Our pupils wear their uniform with pride.

Required School Uniform:

- Grey trousers/shorts or skirt /pinafore dress/ red checked summer dresses
- $\circ$  White polo shirt
- $\circ$  Red sweatshirt or cardigan
- o Black Shoes

## Required P.E. Kit:

- Drawstring bag (labelled clearly with child's name to keep all kit in)
- Red shorts
- o White t shirt
- Plain red/grey or black tracksuit
- o Trainers
- Swimming in years 1 to 4 Costume/ trunks shorts not knee-length shorts, towel, cap (compulsory) Goggles may be worn. A little talc put in the cap at home helps your child to put their own cap on.

## Required Forest School Kit:

- Long trousers/tracksuit bottoms
- Long sleeved tops/jumpers (Plenty of layers needed in winter)
- Spare socks/trousers in case of wet weather
- Waterproof trousers and jacket or puddlesuit
- Wellington boots

Optional School Uniform:

- o Red fleece
- Red PE hoodie
- Branded school jumpers, cardigans or polo shirts
- Football boots and shin-pads may be worn when attending extra-curricular clubs and competitions



Uniform embroidered with the school logo can be purchased from two suppliers:

School fleeces, tee-shirts, waterproof jackets, hats and bags are also available from both suppliers although branded uniform is not compulsory. Children may wear plain red cardigans or jumpers and plain white polo shirts.

Please remember to mark EVERY item of clothing with your child's name and then we will be able to re-unite them with mislaid items. If another child takes your child's jumper home by mistake then a named jumper is more likely to be returned.

## Jewellery

Items of jewellery can cause accidents or a great deal of pain to a child therefore we request you do not allow your child to wear jewellery in school. Jewellery is not allowed during any kind of physical activity e.g. games, P.E., swimming. Before allowing your child to have their ears pierced please consider the problems this may cause in school. Earrings left in for P.E. need to be covered with sticking plasters. Watches may be worn but children must remember they are responsible for their own things.

## Hairstyles

Hair must be of natural colouring and in an appropriate style for school and preferably long hair to be tied-back/ plaited etc.
